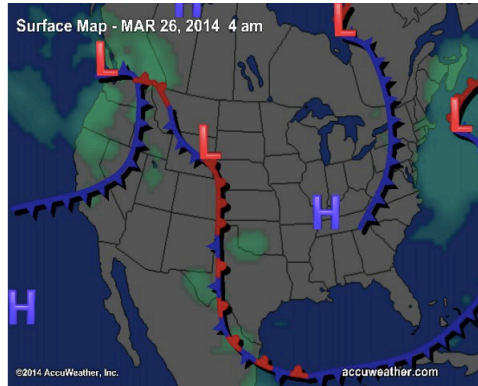

8. Temperature
9. Any other data you feel necessary
